




GDP ACROSS THE WORLD




GDP GROWTH RATE ACROSS THE WORLD

Understanding Growth

Output is produced using factors of production, i.e.,

- Capital
- *Labour* (human capital)
- *Technology* (ideas)
- *Public goods* (road, bridges, rule of law, ...)
- *Institutions*

Causes of Growth

Proximate causes of growth

accumulation of factors

 i.e., accumulating capital for production

Fundamental causes of growth

enabling conditions that facilitate factor accumulation
 i.e., factors that facilitate accumulation of capital


Endogeneity of institutions and its effect on growth

 As circumstances within the country changes, institutions evolves, which in turn changes the circumstances of the country

 i.e., fertility rate


Critical to understand how to *start* this process and ensures that it *does not stop* once it is started




POPULATION AND GDP PER-CAPITA






GDP PER UNIT OF CAPITAL

GROWTH RATE & GDP PER-CAPITA




GROWTH FRAMEWORK

Growth as we understand it


- Countries accumulate factors and grow till their GPD per capita reaches a certain level (convergence)
- The exact level they converge to depends on their own institutions (conditional convergence)
- Once they have reached this level, they grow only if they can invent new ideas (*Endogenous growth*)
- Reason countries remain *poor* is because something is stopping their institutions from evolving (*fundamental factor*)








INCOME PER-CAPITA ACROSS DIFFERENT STATES






POPULATION ACROSS DIFFERENT STATES







PER-CAPITA INCOME ACROSS DIFFERENT STATES































SUMMARY

- Growth is determined by the fundamental factors.
- The fundamental factors are itself sticky and endogenous
- Mystery surrounds the structural break in India's growth in 1979
- Difficult to pick whether certain reforms that caused the structural break or the structural break led to reforms
- Post-1979 growth has been led by manufacturing, construction, finance and real estate sectors
- There is convergence story in play across Indian states where some states are leading and others playing catch up
